#### **Important Communications:**

- Car stickers can be picked up from the gate guard starting on Opening Day on Memorial Day Weekend upon presentation of your car registration showing Huntington Beach residency and Name matching your membership application.
- All other stickers can be picked up at the guard shack after beach opening on Memorial Day Weekend upon presentation of a valid ID showing name matching your membership application.
- Boaters must supply a copy of current boat registration or documentation for all vessels, including power boats, sailboats, jet skis, etc. showing valid Huntington Beach address and Town of Huntington Mooring Permit number (if applicable). Keys and stickers will not be issued without this information. HBCA boat stickers must be affixed to the boat windshield.
- Boater's Keys to Boat Ramp and Parking Lot must be turned in annually prior to obtaining key for next season or "Lost Key" fee of \$25 will be assessed.
- Members with deeds requiring mandatory payment of dues must pay full Regular dues.

<b>Commercial Boating Membership* (Copy of NYS Registration Required)</b> - All commercial applications will be evaluated and reviewed on a case-by-case basis each year by the Board of Directors.			
<b>Property Maintenance Membership (Sustaining)</b> - Includes the right to participate in all HBCA sponsored events, General Meetings and vote. Does not include use of beach facilities, parking lot, boat ramp, or rent of the casino.			
<b>Dinghy/Kayak Sticker</b> - Members in good standing can pay an additional fee for use of the dinghy/kayak racks. The sticker must be placed on the stern side of your vessel; <b>otherwise it will be considered abandoned property.</b> Larger craft such as catamarans, paddleboats and the like are not permitted for dinghy rack use and are not to be left on beach property.
