HOW WILL REGISTRATION WORK?

Log on to [HBCA.org](https://www.hbca.org) and click the link for **HBCA Summer Rec registration**.

Fill out the google form.

Once your form is submitted, it will be reviewed to make sure you are a member in good standing and you don't owe any money from last summer.

We will be registering **HBCA members FIRST**, early registration is for members of the neighborhood only.

REGISTRATION CONTINUED

Payment must be made **in full** at the time the link is received. You may pay using Venmo (@HBCA-Centerport) or by Credit Card. There will be the option to pay via Check or Cash ON REGISTRATION NIGHT ONLY. We will open early registration and then on the last night you will have the opportunity to pay via Cash or check.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR HBCA SUMMER REC?

The HBCA Board met to review our rules and regulations pertaining to all things HBCA. In regards to Summer Rec; This is a privilege for those that live within our neighborhood. It is offered to members in good standing (current member, no past due payments, etc.) HBCA is also offered to Grandchildren that are **STAYING** with their Grandparents. Grandchildren that live elsewhere may not use their Grandparents address to attend camp. Grandparents registering their grandchild must attest that the child will be living at the grandparents home during the time they will be attending summer rec.

CAMP GROUPS

Each group will continue to have a limited number of campers. For safety reasons the camper to counselor ratio must be kept at 3:1.

The groups will have 2 counselors each as well as CITs.

Sports, Art, Theater will have 1 main counselor along with an assistant CIT.

Counselors and CITs will stay with their own group of campers for the entirety of the day.

PICK UP AND DROP OFF : 9:15AM - 2:15PM

Each group will have a designated area. This is where your child will be dropped off and picked up from each day.

Parents unfortunately ARE NOT permitted to stay with their child during camp hours.

Pre K & K will be dropped off at/in the Casino.

1st will be under the awning behind the casino.

2, 3, 4 will be dropped off under the pavilion.

5, 6, 7 will be under the tent by the playground.

All drops off locations are subject to change depending on the number of campers in each group.

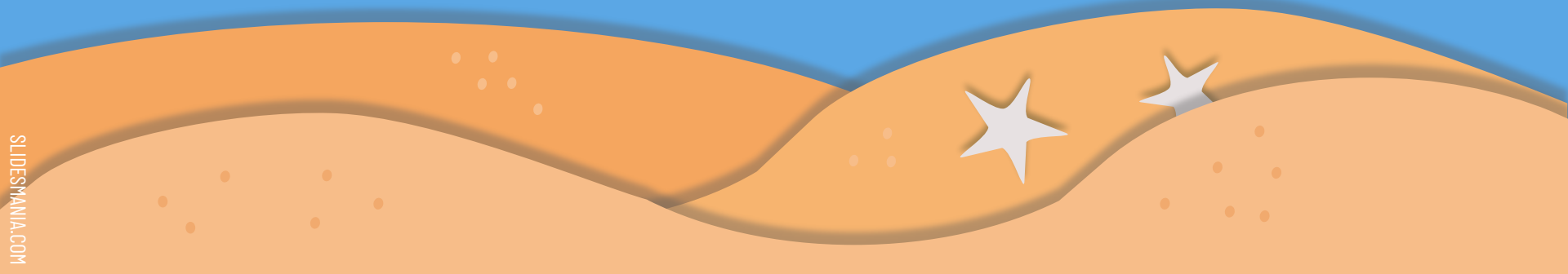
Pickups will occur in the same location.

CAMP HOURS

Drop Off is at 9:15 am.

Pick up is 2:15 pm.

Please be aware that Pick Up must be promptly at 2:15pm.



CAMP RULES

For the safety of all campers and CIT's

Campers **must** stay with their group for the day. Unless given permission by their counselor. Counselors must know where their campers are at all times. CITS must also stay with their group.

Campers must move with their group to the different activities throughout the day. They unfortunately can't hang at a preferred activity to avoid a less preferred activity. For example, if a group is moving from Sports to Art, everyone has to go to art, they can't stay at sports.

CAMP RULES CONTINUED

Please speak to your child about camp behavior and expectations. All campers are expected to be respectful of their counselors and fellow campers. The use of foul, inappropriate, or threatening language, is not tolerated at camp. This behavior will result in a warning first, after a warning has been given if this behavior continues there will be a one day suspension from camp. A third occurrence will result in a weeks suspension from camp. If there is any type of physically harmful behavior you will receive a call and need to pick your child up immediately from camp, your child will be suspended for the rest of the day as well as the next day. If there is a second occurrence of physically harmful behavior your child will not be permitted to come back to camp for the remainder of the summer. This rule applies for counselors and CIT's as well.
